Formal ground breaking held for new 4-H building

On Saturday afternoon during a brief ceremony at the Antelope County Fairgrounds, a ground breaking ceremony was held. Members of the Antelope County Fair Board were the first to don shovels to pitch dirt as construction has begun for the new 4-H Youth Enrichment Center. Fundraising began over two years ago for the building and, earlier this year, surpassed \$400,000 in donations from families and businesses. When completed, it will house archery events along with small animals - poultry, rabbits and more. The committee responsible for fundraising (shown above) also participated in the ceremony as well 4-Hers.

School tax levy likely to fall again

District #18 school board members last week were given an update on the preparation of the 2024/25 school budget and levy which will be voted on next month. Superintendent Mike Brockhaus told the five board members present (Ron Bode was absent from the meeting), that much is yet to be determined as the Nebraska Legislature continues to meet in a special session called by Governor Jim Pillen last month.

He said it's possible the school district will be part of a joint public hearing to be held at the Antelope County Courthouse next month regarding the proposed school budget, despite the real possibility that the 2024/25 tax levy could drop.

He said the county valuation, set by County Assessor Kelli Mueller-Oltjenbruns, came in higher than anticipated (see separate story).

"We are looking good going forward," the superintendent said. A budget workshop to go over the budget will be held the last week of August.

As part of the ongoing process, the board approved a resolution increasing the school district's base growth percentage used to determine the school district's property tax request authority by up to seven percent.

Brockhaus said were the district to take the full seven percent, that would amount to \$338,000. However, he told board members it's more likely that the increase in tax asking will be closer to 3.5 percent. Right now, he said with county valuation figure, the tax levy could decrease by as much as 1.5 cents.

District #18 valuation in county nears \$782 million

Valuations for tax subdivisions have been certified by Antelope County Assessor Kelli Mueller-Oltjenbruns.

The valuations were posted on the county's website last week. Valuations are up from one year ago.

For Elgin School District #18, the new school district taxable value (in Antelope County) is \$781,349,874, up from \$707,169,419 last year.

Since District #18 extends into portions of Boone and Wheeler Counties, those figures must be added to get the final district valuation. In Boone County, this year's taxable value is \$63,726,497. At Wheeler County, the taxable value this year is \$27,744,572.

When all three figures are added together, the total taxable value for Tax Year 2024 is \$872,820,943. One year ago it was \$783,392,234.

This marks the third year in a row that the district's valuation has risen.

City of Elgin

The 2024 City of Elgin valuation was set at \$64,276,701. The number is up from one year ago when the total real property valuation was just over \$55.4 million. Real percentage growth is 0.93 percent.

Petersburg
The 2024 valuation for the Village of Petersburg, set by Boone County Assessor Dan Lueken, is \$34,166,886. The figure is up from the 2023 total real property valuation of \$29,179,112.

County valuation

The county assessor set the 2024 total tax valuation for Antelope County at \$299,436,661. One year ago the total real property valuation was \$2,593,054,653. Real percentage growth is 0.52 percent.

Pickled Peaches & Hot Dilly Beans



Good day, Good day, I just want to share a couple more of my canning ideas! Please try these Peaches, they are amazing!
JoAnn

PICKLED PEACHES
1-29 oz can peach halves (drain and reserve the juice)
1/4 cup vinegar
2 whole cloves for each peach
1 stick cinnamon
1/2 cup sugar
Combine vinegar, sugar and juice from the peaches. Microwave until liquid boils. Put cloves and cinnamon in the mixture. Pour syrup over the peaches. Chill! Let stand for 48 hours in fridge. Serve on lettuce leaves with cottage cheese!

HOT DILLY BEANS
2 lbs green beans trimmed
1 tsp cayenne pepper
4 heads dill
2-1/2 cups 5% vinegar
4 cloves garlic
2-1/2 cups water
Pack beans in hot pint jars leaving 1/4 inch headspace. Into each jar add 1/4 tsp cayenne, 1 clove garlic and 1 head of dill. Combine remaining ingredients and bring to a boil. Pour boiling liquid over green beans, leaving 1/4 inch headspace. Seal and process in water bath for 10 minutes.

This is so hard for our youth to do especially in the social media environment. Watch out for those young-uns. Like this nurturing place we call Elgin, it takes a village to raise a child. As summer winds down here, best not to take a rain check on fun time with family and friends. Yep, a late summer trip might rack up some bills such as take-out from your favorite burger joint. At the end of the day, you can't take it with you!

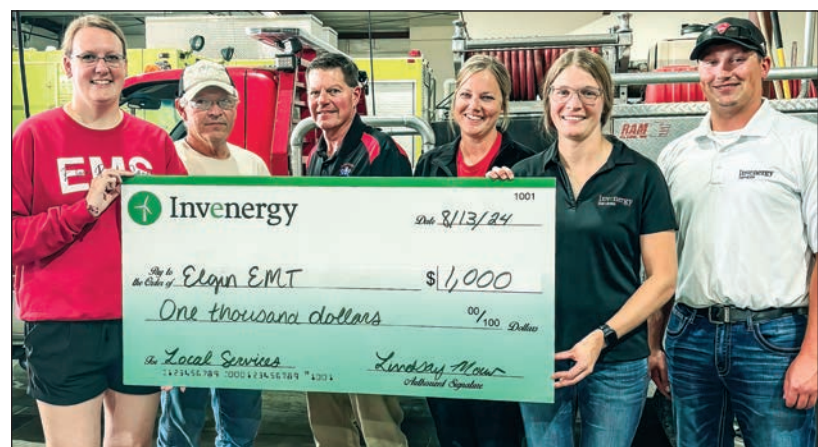

Nebraska native revs up interest

Nebraska isn't known as a battleground state when it comes to presidential elections.

That tag usually goes to Wisconsin, Pennsylvania and Michigan, along with Georgia, Nevada and Arizona.

But the recent pick of Nebraska native and Minnesota Gov. Tim Walz as the vice presidential running mate for Kamala Harris is revving up talk that the Cornhusker State - at least Omaha's congressional district - is in play, and may help decide this fall's presidential election.

Walz, a 60-year-old former teacher and National Guard member, has some deep roots in Nebraska, especially its small towns.

He was born in West Point, grew up in Valentine, and graduated from high school in Butte, a community just south of the South Dakota border.

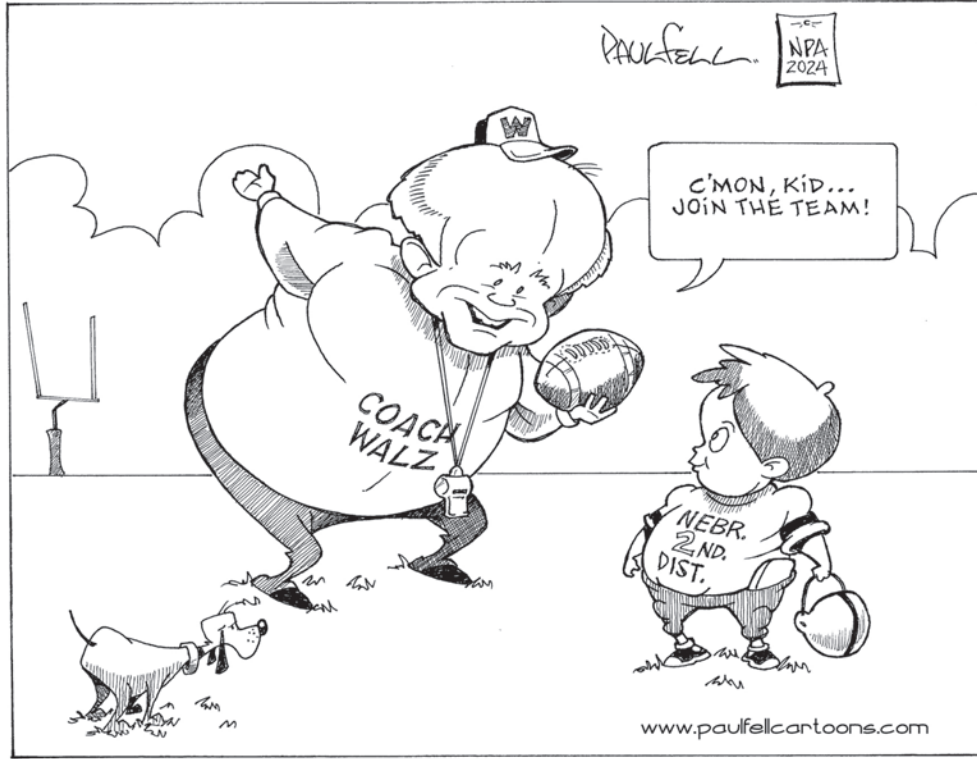
His mother still lives in Butte, population 270, where Walz' graduating class had 25 seniors.

Walz, who served five terms in the U.S. House of Representatives before being elected governor in 2018, often cites his small-town background in explaining his approach to politics.

Be a good neighbor, and mind your business "on a lot of things," he told the Nebraska Examiner 11 months ago.

"Go neighbor to neighbor, talk to them," he said. "(And) explain to them that why demonizing people who are choosing to marry a person that they love really doesn't impact you in any way."

Politicians, Walz added, "should stay



focused on the things that improve people's lives."

Having a vice presidential candidate from a rural, agricultural state is sort of unusual in such campaigns, which usually find someone in a three-piece suit as a running mate, not someone who likes to wear Minnesota Viking sweatshirts.

If elected, he would be at least the third vice president with Nebraska connections to hold the office.

The others were Gerald Ford, who was born in Omaha, Dick Cheney, who was born in Lincoln, and Charles Dawes, who served under President Calvin Coolidge. Dawes began his law career in Lincoln. (Dawes also owned the house that became Billy's Restaurant, the go-to hangout just a block from the Nebraska State Capitol where lobbyists and senators go to decompress. Dawes, by the way is not the namesake of Dawes County, by the way.)

That distinction goes to James Dawes, who was governor of Nebraska when the county was formed in 1885.)

Walz was portrayed in an article in Politico as a "moderate-leaning Democrat with a good sense for tapping into local issues the district cared about."

He also has gotten an "A" rating from the National Rifle Association, which usually backs more conservative candidates.

Which brings us to the 2nd Congressional District in Omaha, which has been dubbed Nebraska's "Blue Dot" because it has backed a Democrat for president twice in the past four presidential elections (Barack Obama in 2008 and Biden in 2020). The state, along with Maine, has a unique system of awarding some of its electoral votes for president by congressional district.

Underlining the importance the Blue Dot might play in 2024, former President Donald Trump recently opened a campaign office in Omaha. President Joe Biden already had an office in the district, and its staff was quickly absorbed by the Harris-for-president team after Biden dropped out.

A lot of things would have to happen, but it's conceivable that the Omaha district and its single electoral vote could provide the margin for victory in what has been portrayed as a very tight race for the White House.

So rather than being a political "fly over" state, Nebraska, and particularly Omaha, might see some real campaign rallies this autumn. And some will likely feature a popular Minnesota governor who has roots in this state.

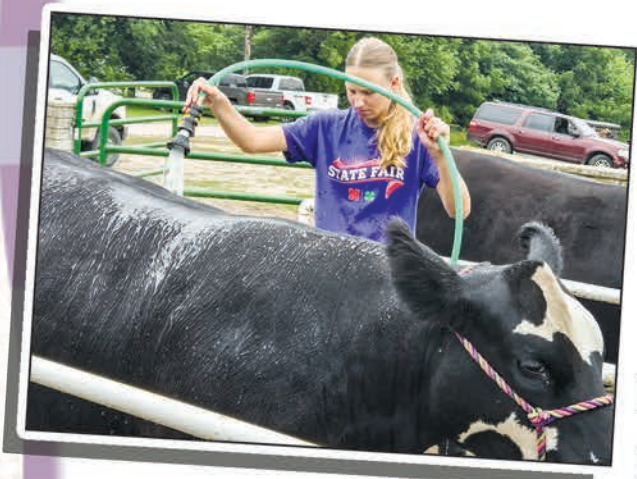

A celebration of Spanish cuisine for Hispanic Heritage Month

Each year, beginning on September 15 and extending to October 15, communities across the country celebrate National Hispanic Heritage Month. The United States has benefitted from a boom in its Hispanic population over the last half century, making Hispanic Heritage Month a worthy reason to celebrate for Americans from all cultural backgrounds.

The cultural contributions of Hispanics in the U.S. are too numerous to mention them all. Cuisine is one such contribution, and there's seemingly no end to the flavorful dishes individuals can enjoy as they seek to celebrate Hispanic heritage this September and October. Individuals who want a taste of Spain can try their hands at this recipe for "Cantimpalitos (Grilled Mini Chorizos with Potato Purée)" from James Campbell Caruso's "España: Exploring the Flavors of Spain" (Gibbs Smith).



Cantimpalitos

(Grilled Mini Chorizos with Potato Purée)
Serves 6

2 pounds potatoes, cut into quarters
1/4 cup olive oil
6 cloves garlic
2 tablespoons butter
3 tablespoons heavy cream
1 tablespoon chopped fresh sage
Salt to taste
36 cantimpalitos (mini chorizos)

In a large pot of boiling water, boil the potatoes until soft. In a skillet, heat the olive oil and garlic together on medium heat for 7 minutes, until the garlic is cooked through, soft and brown. Drain the potatoes and put them in a food processor with the garlic, olive oil, butter, cream, sage, and salt. Purée well and set aside; keep hot.

Heat a grill to medium-high heat. Thread cantimpalitos onto skewers, 6 pieces per serving. Grill for 4 minutes per side. Divide purée onto 6 plates and top each serving with a skewer of grilled sausages.

EPPJ netters urged to 'trust the climb'

ELGIN — Three simple words "Trust The Climb" may shape the course of the 2024/25 volleyball season for Elgin Public-Pope John.

Those words are to help guide the team as they jump up one class and face new foes in an effort to go to State in back-to-back years.

"We obviously want to get to the top, but we know we're rebuilding," Coach Jordynn Luettel said. "It's trusting that we're not going to be at the level we were at the end of last year. We got to trust that climb, trust that we're going to get better each game so by postseason we're hopefully at the top."

Head Coach Jordynn Luettel enters her second season at the helm of the Wolfpack with a roster full of upper classmen and long on experience.

Last season saw the Wolfpack playing in Lincoln in November. The team posted a 28-5 record culminating in a four-set victory over Guardian Angels CC in the consolation finals.

The experience the team gained, in the heat of battle against the state's best, gives this year's team an opportunity to be the best-ever for EPPJ

if they close out the state tournament the way many believe they can.

"They're (the team) more hungry," Luettel said last week. "Even more hungry than when I saw them last year. We want to be back down in Lincoln. Their eyes are set on the championship."

As practice builds up to Thursday night's jamboree against Stanton and the start of the regular season one week later at Lutheran High Northeast, the strength of the team may be the front row. Chloe Henn returns for her senior season as the team's leading hitter. Last year, Henn recorded 330 kills as opponents found her hard to stop. "She's really been getting up and getting the ball down this summer, so it's been exciting," Luettel said about Henn. "She's getting smarter with her attacks hitting the spot."

Equally effective was senior Sara Bode who posted 208 kills last year. Sara was one of the team's main 'go-to' hitters last season.

Juniors Camry Kittelson and Kayton Zwingman and sophomore Braelyn Martinsen

will be trustworthy options as the Wolfpack will run a 6-2 attack. Natalie Burenheide's height will be a big asset at the net when called upon.

The success of the team may well rest with the setters as record setter Baylee Busted completed her career last season. In her final campaign, Busted had 903 of the team's 1,043 set assists. Stepping up to fill the position are six-rotation player Kittelson, senior Kaitey Schumacher and sophomore Elizabeth Moser.

Libero Kate Furstenau, one of the best in the area, is back for her final year. Furstenau led the team in digs last season with 543 and 489 in serve receive. "She is one of the best defenders I've coached, and I've coached a lot of girls. She reads the ball really well, she anticipates and beats it (the ball). She has all the tools," Luettel said.

Serving specialist Callie Heithoff leads a group of talented reserves looking to make their mark. They include Brooke Kinney and Mady Kurpgeweit. As good as the Wolfpack can

be, they face a challenge not of their own making. After years playing Class D1, EPPJ has been bumped up to Class C2. This year the NSAA has divided up Class C2 into four districts. The Wolfpack are in District #2, arguably the toughest in the state. Also in the district are Crofton, Lutheran High Northeast, Norfolk Catholic, Hartington Cedar Catholic, Summerland and Elkhorn Valley. The Wolfpack, year in and year out, play a very tough schedule to prepare them for a successful run in the postseason. The Wolfpack will play six matches on the road before playing their home opener on September 12 against Boyd County. New this year as an assistant coach is Jill McNally to work alongside Sandy Henn. McNally replaces Assistant Coach Kim Zwingman.
